GATHER TOGETHER DOCUMENTS AND INFORMATION

- Medical information
- Doctors' names, addresses, and phone numbers
- Medical Records
- Immunization Records
- Insurance Cards
- Legal Papers: Birth Certificates, Social Security Cards, Divorce or Custody papers, Income verification, Pay stubs or Unemployment statement.

CONTACT THE RESOURCE AGENCY TO ASK FOR ASSISTANCE

Be clear about what you want. Have your documents together. Write down the date, who you talked to, and what you are told. Repeat the information so you know its right.

If the agency cannot help you, ask who can. Be persistent!

You may have to make several contacts and talk to several people, but hang in there.
