Flow Chart

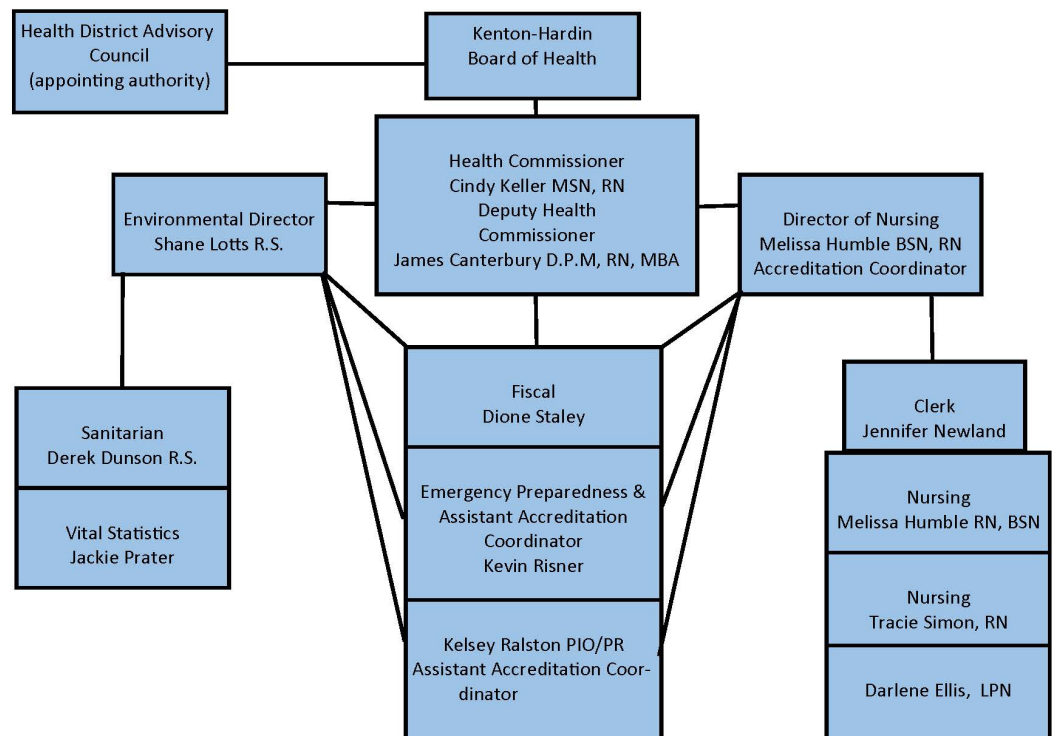

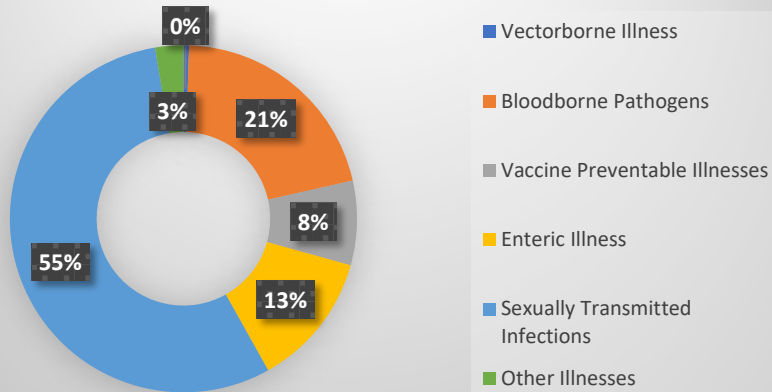

Types of Communicable Diseases Reported, Hardin County 2020

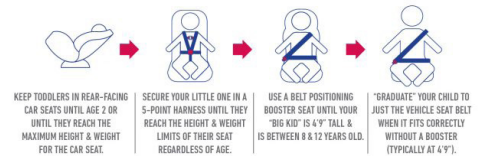

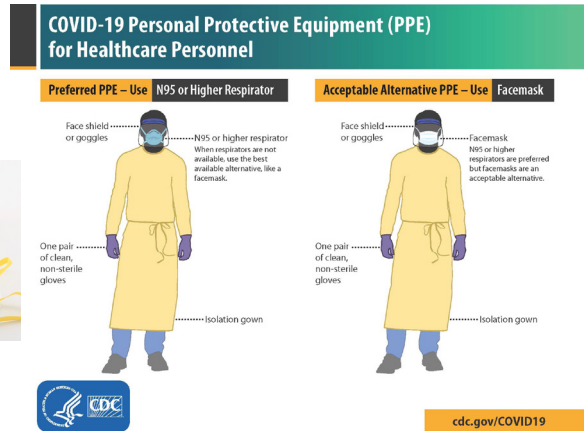
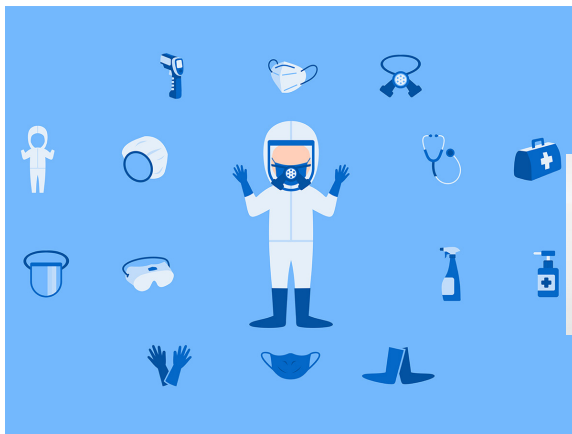

Emergency Preparedness

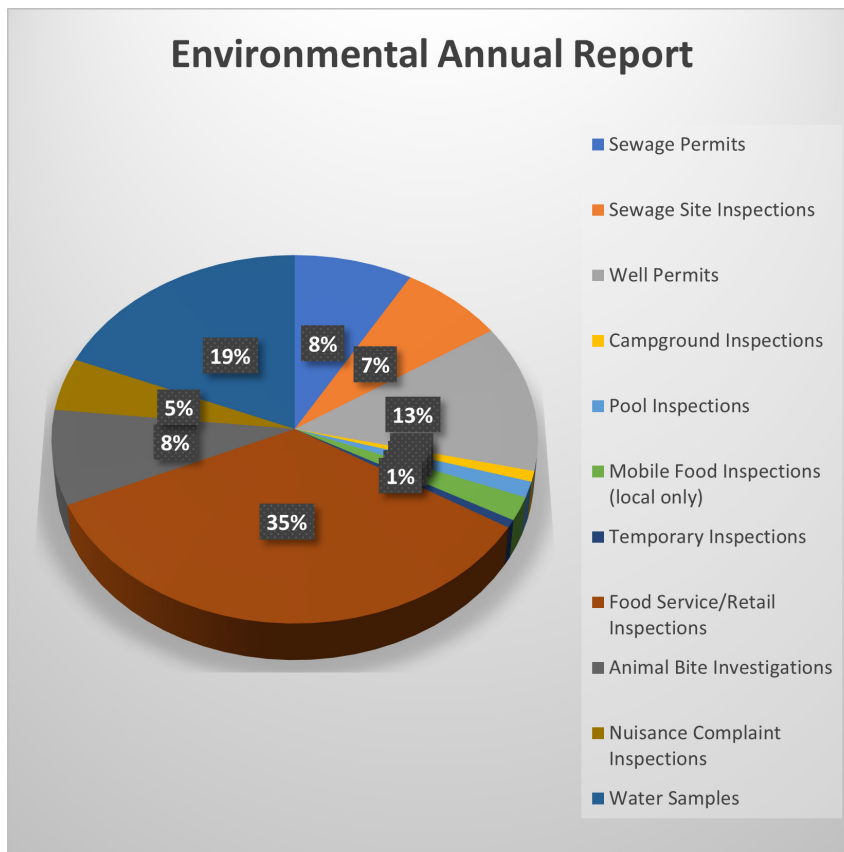
2020 was a year of response. We started the year distributing Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to our responding agencies.

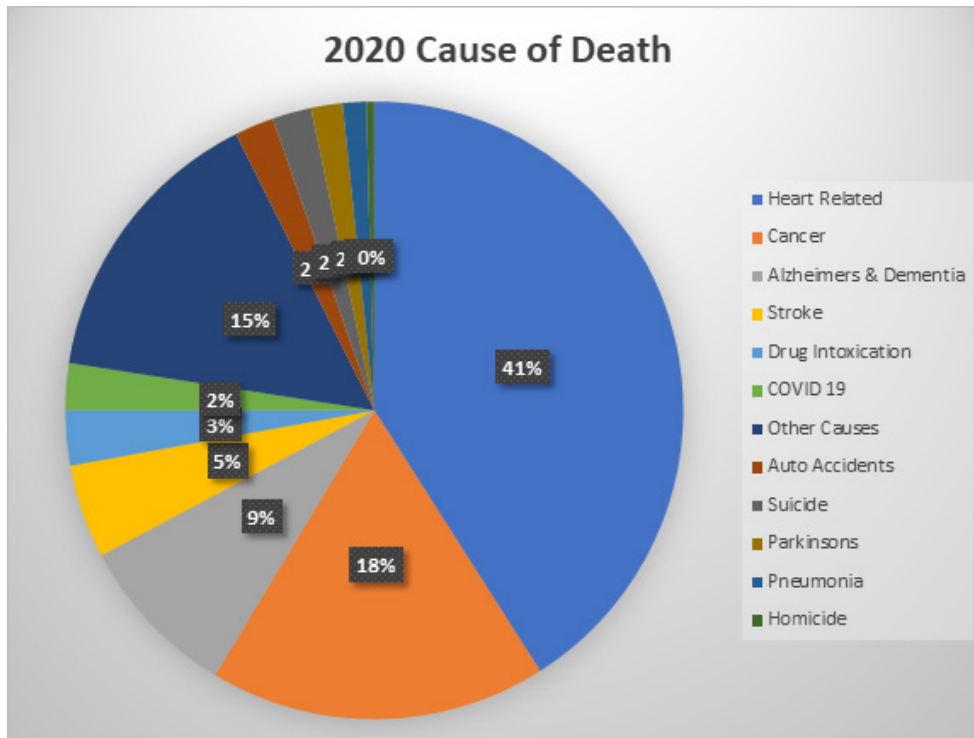
