## Flow Chart

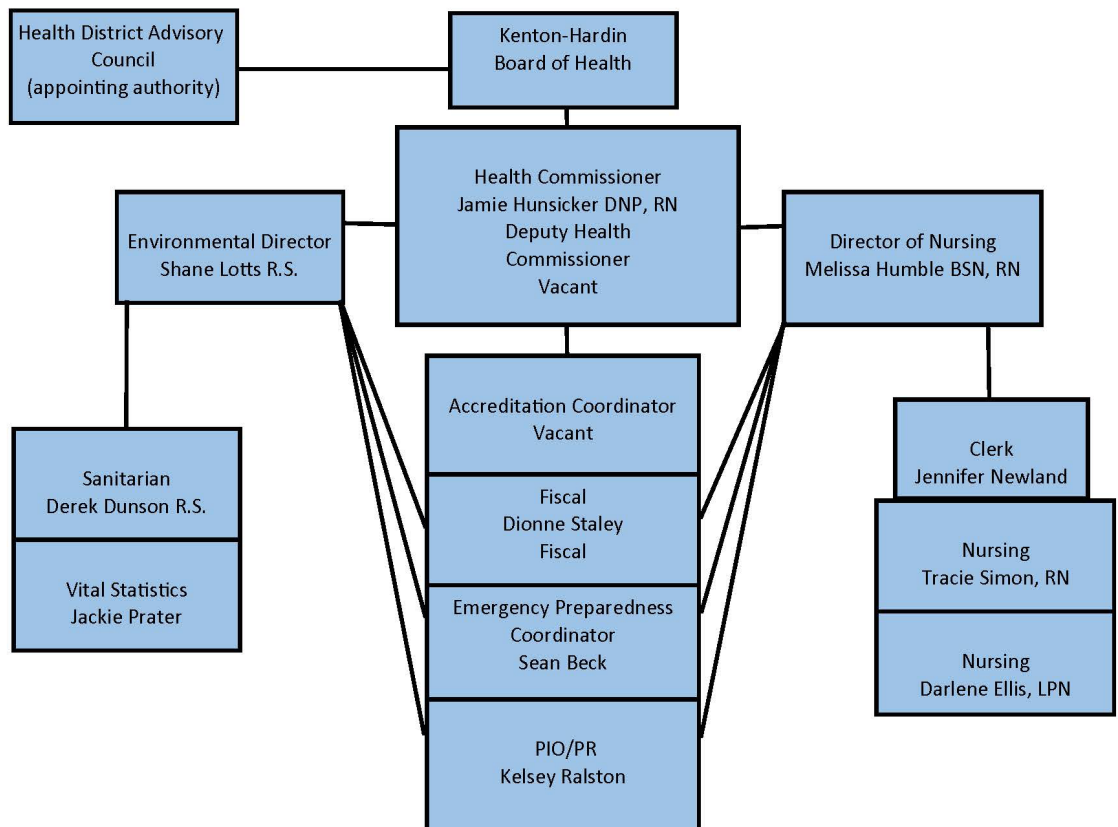

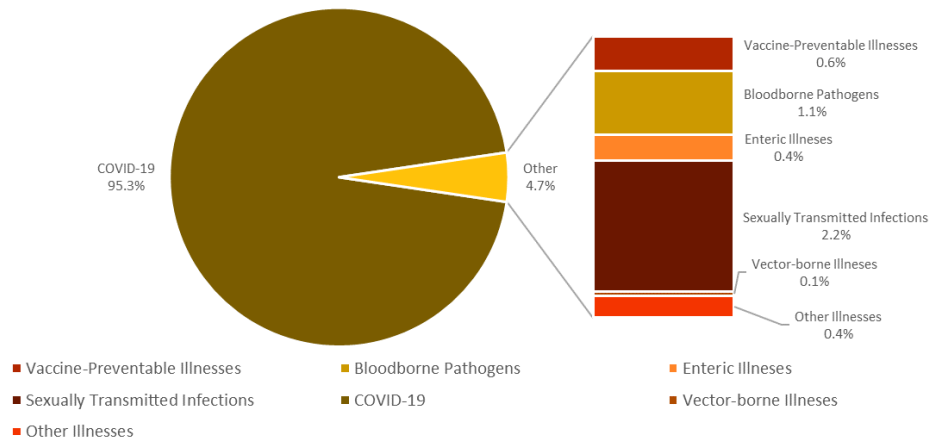

## COVID-19 Response

Our first case of COVID-19 was reported April 1, 2020. Nurses and staff began giving vaccines on **December 30, 2020**. We had 32 drive thru clinics at the Hardin County Fairgrounds, and have given COVID vaccines at our offices consistently throughout the year.



### What is "mixing and matching"?

"Mixing and matching" is getting a different COVID-19 booster than your initial vaccine.

- Johnson & Johnson recipients should get boosted with Pfizer or Moderna
- It is recommended that Pfizer and Moderna recipients get the same booster as their initial shot, but may mix and match depending on preference/availability

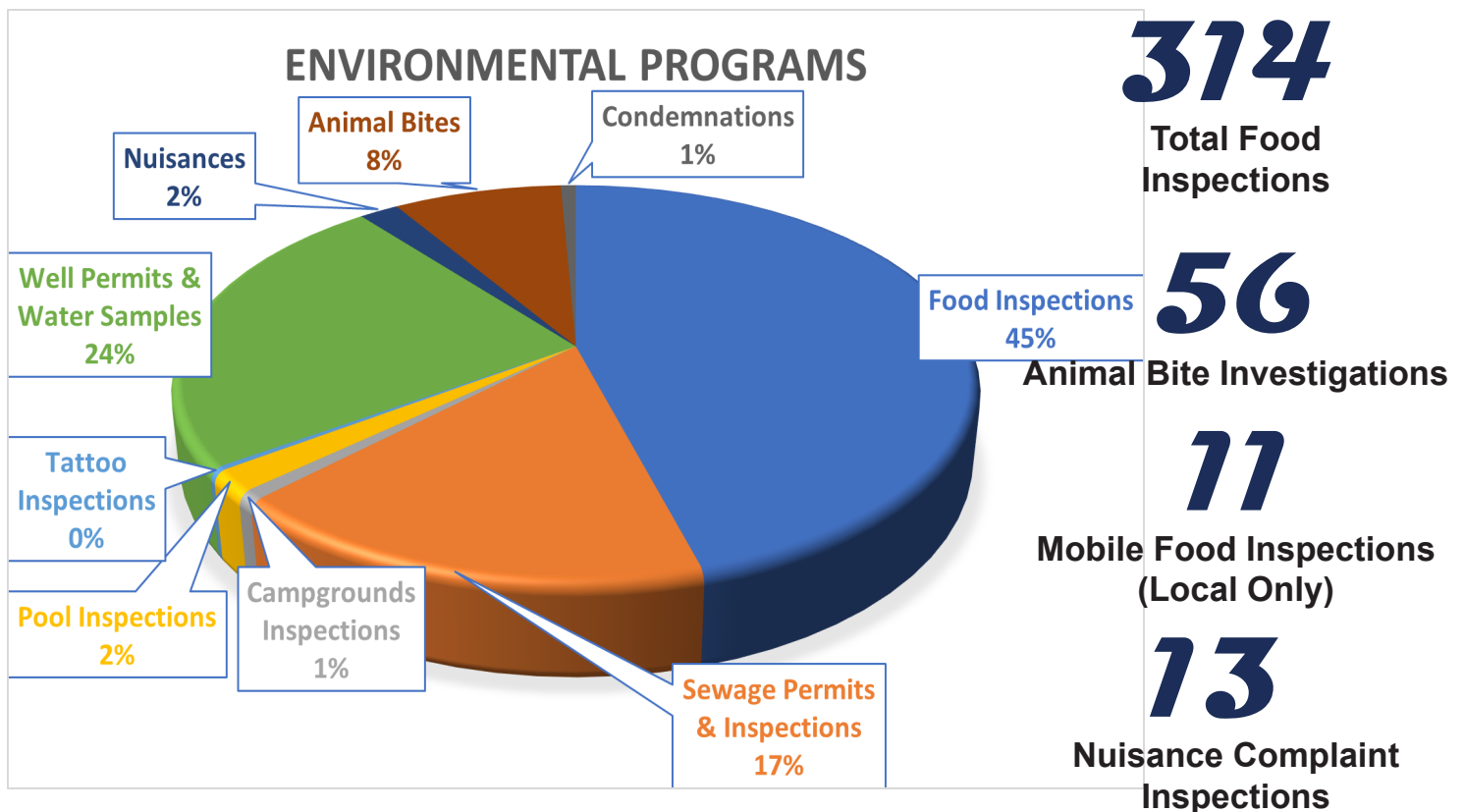

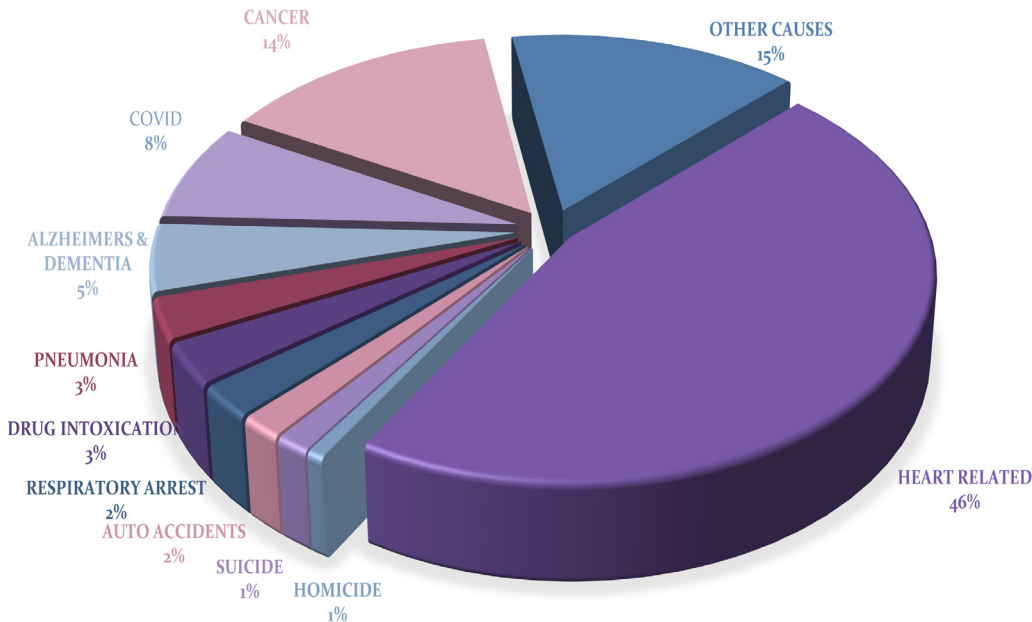
